

Parent & Student Check List

- Check your email every night for the next day's classes. Mark your calendars and use alerts to remind you when class will start.
- Clear a space that you can move, stretch and dance in. If it's a nice day, go ahead and dance outside.
- Some Classes will have special things that you will need; lyrics, theraband etc. Don't worry, we will let you know what you need. We will list it on the schedule.
- Have hair up/back and proper dance attire on along with shoes.
- For younger students, I suggest a parent help with chat, or "raising your hand" to ask questions.
- Have a water bottle close by for water breaks.
- About 5min before the scheduled class time, join the appropriate level class. (See the schedule with the breakdown of levels). You will be in a waiting room until the teacher starts the class so just be patient until start time.

My child only takes PreBallet I. Can they take a Jazz class? YES. Not only that, they can take the Tap, Hip Hop AND a Wild Card Class. PreBallet I is listed under the BEG category, so they can take all the BEG online level classes. Same rules apply to the CM, JR & SR categories.

My child doesn't have Tap shoes. Can she still take the class? YES. Have them wear their jazz or ballet shoes. Dress shoes that have a hard heel work great too.

What are the Wild Card Classes? Every week, we will be offering different styles of dance, or exercise, strength/flexibility classes. These classes will rotate/change weekly.

Will the schedule remain the same? I don't see my teacher listed. Since this is the first week of classes, we have a lot of learning to do. My intention is to keep the classes the same each week and have different teachers teaching. They may vary depending on the teachers availability.

How long are the classes? We are aiming around 45 minutes to an hour. The JR & SR Ballet classes are 1.5 hours.

I have 2 kids that need to take different classes at the same time. How do I do that? Put them in separate rooms on separate devices. You don't need a full zoom account to view a class just the meeting number and password. You can run the zoom app on a phone without a login.

We appreciate your patience. This literally is like building a studio from scratch. Hopefully this week will answer a lot of your questions. Play around with the app. It is quite intuitive and easy to navigate. There is a Chat feature, Raise your Hand button to ask a question, as well as thumbs up and applaud emojis. And give your teachers some leeway too. They are learning along side you as well.
